HE OR SHE VERBS-DOING WORDS E.G. RUNNING ADVERBS- DESCRIBE THE VERB E.G. SUDDENLY CONNECTIVES- WORDS THAT BRING TWO SENTENCES TOGETHER E.G. AND OR BECAUSE.
